Introduction



This course has been specifically designed to provide maintenance engineers and handymen with the competency required to undertake a narrow scope of electrical work safely and with confidence.

Tasks such as like-for-like replacement of damaged socket covers, light switches and other fittings are routinely carried out in the home but at work such activities fall under the Electricity at Work Regulations 1989 which require persons to be competent to avoid serious or even fatal electric shock accidents and fires.

Who is this course for?

The course is intended for maintenance personnel who need to carry out basic electrical tasks such as like-for-like replacement of damaged socket covers, light switches and other fittings as part of their work.

There are six modules to be completed:

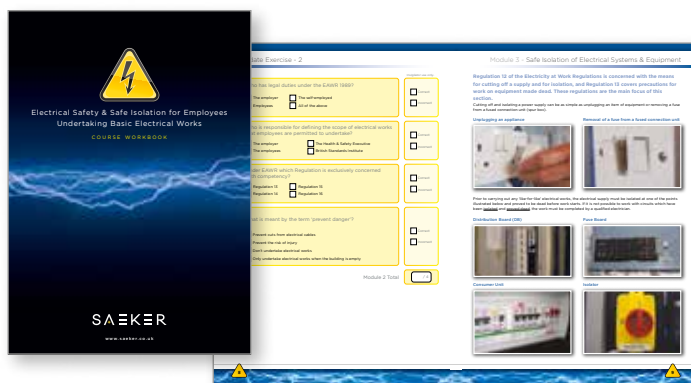
- + Introduction and dangers of electricity
- + Legislation and competency
- + Safe isolation of electrical systems and equipment
- + Identification and in-service user / formal visual inspection of electrical appliances
- + Changing electrical appliance plugs
- + Working at height

Expected self-study time

The course is designed to be completed in one sitting and will take around one and half hours.

The course pack also has a permit to work included for low voltage like-for-like electrical works that can be freely copied and used as part of your safe system of work.
