



## Course details

### Introduction

Delegates can expect to learn how to move, site and level caravans safely and correctly, thereby improving customer experience and reducing the likelihood of damage and unnecessary warranty claims. Our trainers will not only ensure that your employees learn the practical skills to move and site caravans safely, they will also ensure they are working efficiently, making best use of time and resources.

### Brief course overview

Each course will cover the following elements

- + An awareness of relevant health and safety legislation for work equipment, PPE, manual handling, lifting equipment and pressure systems, etc.
- + Overview of chassis and caravan design relevant to safety and warranty protection.
- + Identifying hazards, implementing effective controls and completing checks.
- + Towing safely and effective communication.
- + Practical instruction and involvement by each delegate for the safe movement, siting, leveling and de-siting of a single unit caravan.
- + Site licence requirements for caravan spacing.
- + Effective preparation and safety during craning operations.
- + Awareness of vacant pitch safety, working safely around utilities and caravan step safety.

The course encourages maximum delegate participation through the use of media, case studies and group discussion.

### Assessment & certification

This is an integrated training and assessment programme. Each delegate is subject to continuous assessment throughout the course, via completion of a risk assessment, practical demonstration and observation & completion of a workbook. Successful completion will lead to each delegate receiving a RoSPA certificate.

### Costs

The fully inclusive fee (including certification) for each course held in mainland UK is £2,485, for up to 6 delegates. Each additional delegate over 6 up to a maximum of 10 is charged at £200.00 per delegate. Fees quoted are exclusive of VAT. Where accommodation for the trainer cannot be provided by the client on site, accommodation will be charged at bed & breakfast rates.

### Duration & venue

2 days contact time at the training venue. Courses are held on client premises.

### Delegate entry requirements

There are no pre-course entry requirements. It is desirable for delegates to have some experience or awareness of moving and siting caravans, but this is not essential as full training will be provided. Arrangements are in place for delegates who require learning support. Please contact us for further details.

### Training venue requirements

A training venue with power and table space for each candidate. We also require a screen to project onto or TV to connect to. Delegates can expect to spend one day in the training venue and one day completing the practical elements.

For the practical element we require the use of a towing vehicle (with a competent driver), a single unit caravan in good towable condition, a suitable easy to access base and all work equipment e.g. jacks (with current certificate of examination), levels, blocks, axle stands and ground boards etc.

Every candidate will need to provide personal protective. The minimum requirement is protective footwear, bump cap, work gloves and high visibility upper body clothing. Delegates should wear suitable clothing for all weather conditions.

Arrangements for catering and refreshments will be agreed prior to the course.
